- An urgent and compelling need exists, and following the ordering procedures would result in unacceptable delays.
- Only one source is capable of providing the supplies or services required at the level of quality required because the supplies or services are unique or highly specialized Philips Healthcare has the legal rights to proprietary equipment and software; OEM parts/supplies and factory trained certified technicians. Use of any other source other than Philips Healthcare would void the equipment. Also the mandatory hardware and software upgrades must be provided by a qualified field service engineer.
- In the interest of economy and efficiency, the new work is a logical follow-on to an original Federal Supply Schedule order provided that the original order was placed in accordance with the applicable Federal Supply Schedule ordering procedures. The original order must not have been previously issued under sole source or limited source procedures.
- Items peculiar to one manufacturer:
 - A patent, copyright or proprietary data limits competition. The proprietary data is: (If FAR 8.405-6(a)(2)iii before posting. Do not include specific proprietary data. The price is considered fair and reasonable based on the requirements stated in FAR 8.404(d). The NAC has determined the prices for fixed-price services, and rates for services offered at hourly rates, to be fair and reasonable.

(6) DESCRIBE THE MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AMONG SCHEDULE HOLDERS AND THE RESULTS OR A STATEMENT OF THE REASON MARKET RESEARCH WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

Market research revealed several SDVOSB/VOSB's and two small businesses. Historically, the requested services have been provided by Philips Healthcare. Philips Healthcare is the OEM and has proprietary ownership of all hardware and software to include PM services and parts. PHILIPS HEALTHCARE does not use other distributors.

Market research was conducted via VetBiz Registry and the SBA Dynamic Small Business Database.

(7) ANY OTHER FACTS SUPPORTING THE JUSTIFICATION:

These services have been provided for the GCVHCS, Biloxi MS since Oct. 2011 under a FSS NAC contract using limited source justification to GE. Market research indicates PHILIPS HEALTHCARE has proprietary ownership.

(8) A STATEMENT OF THE ACTIONS, IF ANY, THE AGENCY MAY TAKE TO REMOVE OR OVERCOME ANY BARRIERS THAT LED TO THE RESTRICTED CONSIDERATION BEFORE ANY SUBSEQUENT ACQUISITION FOR THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES IS MADE:

Full and open competition may be sought when the hardware and software required for the equipment are no longer proprietary. It would not be cost effective to replace Philips Healthcare imaging equipment to a brand which does not have proprietary rights.

(9) REQUIREMENTS CERTIFICATION: I certify that the requirement outlined in this justification is a Bona Fide Need of the Department of Veterans Affairs and that the supporting data under my cognizance, which are included in the justification, are accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge. 
