1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, VISN 12, Great Lakes Acquisition Center, 115 S. 84th Street, Milwaukee, WI. Transaction 607-19-1-045-0001.

2. **Brief Description of Supplies/ Services required and the intended use/Estimated Amount:** Provide preventive maintenance, service and software maintenance and updates in support of the D-Spect camera system located at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Hospital. The camera is utilized for cardiac imaging of the Veteran patients. The estimated amount for a base plus four option year contract is \$162,000.00.

3. **Unique characteristics that limit availability to only one source, with the reason no other supplies or services can be used:** The service requires full access to the software during repairs and upgrades. Spectrum Dynamics is the only vendor that can provide the service due to proprietary software.

4. **Description of market research conducted and results or statement why it was not conducted:** A search was conducted of VIP, no vendors were identified, a sources sought notice (36C25218Q9784) was posted to FBO from 8/8/18 – 8/14/18, no responses were received. A notice of intent to sole source (36C25218Q9784-1) was posted to FBO from 8/15/18 – 8/22/18, no responses were received. Spectrum Dynamics is the OEM.
