1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, NCO 16, VA Gulf Coast Veterans Health Care Systems, Biloxi, MS

2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:

Medtronic Pacerart System HL 7 integration module: ECG module; Conmed cable: takes information from patient monitoring device and integrates with electronic medical records.

3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

Pacerart system with session sync will allow integration of the pacemaker/AICD clinic with CPRS and Vista imaging, eliminating the need for paper charts, scanning of paper clinic notes and manual data entry of progress notes for each visit. This system allows tracking of all patients in device clinic, to improve patient compliance with clinic follow up, and patient monitoring. This system also allows for better management of OPTIVOL monitoring via remote monitoring for CHF patients to decrease hospitalization rates. The system will improve the quality of care provided in the Pacemaker/AICD clinic as well improve the information available to employees for management of these patients.

5. Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):

Medtronics system is the system the National ICD Surveillance utilizes. Also, San Francisco is the center that governs the VA decisions regarding AICD/PM care in general and this is the system they use. They are the standard of care in the area.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable: Contracting issued a Sources Sought Notice on July 9, 2012 with responses due July 18, 2012. Only one response was received and that was from Medtronic.

7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable: If no competition is received, then the Contracting shall attempt to received published price list or pricing from other awarded VA or Government contracts.

8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted: As stated in paragraph 6, a Sources Sought Notice was issued and also attempts were made to contact some other companies that may offer this same type item. Only one response was actually received.


