

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. On-site it was mentioned the walls needed to only be 6'w, but they are shown more as 12'w. Please confirm which length is desired.
 - a. As for the size of the wall, yes- 6' wide and it should go all the way up to the ceiling.
2. Under Required Product in the RFQ, letter D states that there are power/data ports on the ceiling which I did see empty conventional boxes for on-site. Will those be a finished outlet and data ports? If so – we will not be able to include any outlets on the wall as those require tying into junction box above ceiling. We would be able to make it work with just plugging in the TV, however the wall would have to be centered on one of the outlets, making it visible on the other side. Please advise.
 - a. Contractor (construction) said it should be power and data in the ceiling
 - b. Okay for wall to be centered on one outlet and visible from other side.
3. Is any AV package pricing to be included in this quote?
 - a. Not needed
4. Is there a TV model selected?
 - a. Wall must hold a 65" or smaller monitor. We don't really know model and make as that still needs to be purchased.
5. I have been looking over the document that outlines the requirements for the project. It look like the panels are spec'd as glass. Would acrylic be an option or is glass a necessity?
 - a. Glass or similar material- we would just request a sample or be directed to a website to approve the material they suggest.
