This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; quotes are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued.

The solicitation number is 36C24819Q1418 and is issued as a Request for Quote (RFQ). This solicitation documents and incorporates provisions and clauses in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular 2019-04, effective 6 Sep 2019. This solicitation starts 9 Sep 2019 and will end 23 Sep 2019 at 12:00 am EST.

Network Contracting Office 8, North Florida/South Georgia Veterans Healthcare System intends to award a Firm Fixed Price service contract for Repair/Rebuild of four (4) trip units for the Malcom Randall Veteran Affairs Medical Center (VAMC). This procurement is being conducted under FAR Subpart 13 and simplified acquisition procedures apply. Period of performance is 24 Sep 2019 – 23 December 2019. The North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) code for this procurement is 335311 with a small business size standard of 750 employees.

This solicitation is being issued as a tiered evaluation for SDVOSB concerns, or in the alternative, a tiered evaluation for VOSB concerns, or in the alternative, a set-aside for other small business concerns with HUBZone small business concerns and 8(a) participants having priority. If an award cannot be made, the solicitation will be cancelled, and the requirement resolicited.

This solicitation will use Comparative Analysis. Award will be made to the offeror determined to be technically acceptable; and price is determined to be reasonable; all eligible offerors may submit quotes. All offerors shall be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) at <https://www.sam.gov> ; and www.vip.vetbiz.va.gov , to be considered for an award of a federal

contract. The record shall be complete and not missing elements such as representations and certifications; and SDVOSB/VOSB shall be certified.

Site Visit: A site visit is scheduled for 10 Sep 2019 at 9am at the Malcom Randall VAMC, Engineering Office, EB87-1, basement main hospital. POC is Ed Burnett or Andrew Turknett. This visit is to allow for review of the four (4) trip units requiring repair/rebuild.

Quotes shall be received 23 Sep 2019 at 12:00 p.m. Eastern Time Zone and reference the solicitation number. Quotes received after this date and time will be considered late in accordance with FAR Provision 52.212-1(f) and will not be evaluated unless the Contracting Officer determines the late quote will be accepted IAW 52.212-1(f)(2)(i)(A-C).

The Government will award a Firm Fixed-Price contract resulting from this RFQ to the responsible contractor whose quote is determined to be Technically Acceptable and is price reasonable in accordance with a Comparative Analysis of the information requested in this solicitation at FAR Provision 52.212-2.

SCHEDULE OF SERVICES

The North Florida/South Georgia Lake City VMAC requires Repair/Rebuild of four (4) trip units for the Malcom Randall Veteran Affairs Medical Center (VAMC) as described in the attached Statement of Work (SOW). The contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, parts, supervisions, services and incidentals required to repair, rebuild, re-plate contact surfaces four (4) trip units. Work shall be completed as required in the SOW. All offerors shall quote prices for each Contract Line Item Numbers (CLIN). ***See Attached Price Schedule for quote submission***

QUOTATION SUBMISSION

Offerors shall submit quotes electronically by the date and time in accordance with the Request for Quote instructions. Quote shall be no more than 5 megabytes or exceed the limits to be submitted electronically via email.

1) Technical.

- a) Provide methodology to be used for repair/rebuild, re-plating surfaces of four (4) trip units including schedule for testing.

- b) Provide a list of personnel assigned to provide the titled service.
- c) Provide copies of Training Certification of personnel identified for system testing and circuit breaker replacement.

2) Past Performance

- a) Provide three (3) references of same scope and cost of work requested.

3) Price.
