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#### I. Using the 'Bypass Normal Data Entry' Option

The 'Bypass normal data entry' option [LRFAST] can be found on your VistA secondary menu. It allows a user to accession a laboratory test and enter the data in a few simple keystrokes. The option is screen captured below with the user input fields highlighted.
