1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, VISN 7, *Birmingham VA Medical Center*
2. **Brief Description of Supplies/ Services required and the intended use/Estimated Amount:**
SSCYS-01-SCOUT CONSOLE 2.5 AND GUIDE VA quote \$57,000.00

Check Console is an accessory to the SAVI SCOUT System. The SCOUT Check Console is a medical device that provides control operations for detecting the presence of the SAVI SCOUT Reflector within breast tissue

3. **Unique characteristics that limit availability to only one source, with the reason no other supplies or services can be used:** The SAVI SCOUT is intended to be used to confirm the functionality of the SAVI SCOUT Reflector subsequent to percutaneous placement in Radiology. Using imaging guidance (such as ultrasound or radiography) or aided by non-imaging guidance (Cianna SAVI SCOUT System) the Cianna Medical SAVI SCOUT Reflector is located and surgically removed with the target tissue. compared to other units, especially important for microcalcifications which are 50 microns or less in size. The machine meets requirements for single source items because they have the following features and capabilities which are not available from any other competitor:
 - Utilizes radar technology to detect an implanted reflector which allows surgeons to perform more complex cases on more patients
 - Depth capability of 60mm
 - Accuracy of measurement to +/- 1mm
 - Insignificant MRI bloom artifact to implanted reflector which allows SCOUT to be used throughout the continuum of care not just prior surgery
 - MRI imaging is important for patients undergoing neoadjuvant therapy and patients with time of biopsy implant – which is current trend for use of SCOUT – a significant MRI artifact impedes clinical review of tumor status
4. Most importantly, our breast team has used this particular machine for some time at UAB, and it has proven to be reliable with excellent image quality. The Birmingham VAMC has authorized to provide exact patient care inhouse using the same equipment to prevent interruption in patient care.
