Crit-line IV Monitors with trade in value and Clips with an estimated value of \$47,500.00.

Critline is the only known monitor that can **non-invasively** measure hematocrit, oxygen saturation, and percent change in blood volume simultaneously.

VIP, FPDS, VA NAC catalog, SAM, FBO, SEWP were all used for market research. No relevant results were found.
