2. **Brief Description of Supplies/ Services required and the intended use/Estimated Amount:**
Laborie U8-4 Nexam Pro CIM Tolley System, with video to be used in the Madison VAMC 6 urology clinic for urodynamics of the bladder and urethra.

3. **Unique characteristics that limit availability to only one source, with the reason no other supplies or services can be used:**
The following unique characteristics that limit availability to only one source, with the reason no other supplies or services can be used are:
 - A. Only system that is validated with documentation for T-DOC air -charged catheters
 - B. LABORIE is the only company to successfully perform an integration with VISTA.
 - C. Ability to transfer patient files from previous MMS and /or LABORIE urodynamics systems.
 - D. Five urologists and fifteen residents work between the Madison VAMC, the UW Health University Hospital, and the American Family Children's Hospital. Continuity between the sites in critical and having differing systems would interfere with the residents training and may potentially compromise clinical decision making and patient care. Laborie UDS machines are currently in service at all three facilities and it is not economically feasible to replace the machines at all three sites to maintain compatibility.
4. **Description of market research conducted and results or statement why it was not conducted:**

A urologist at the facility is a world expert on urodynamics and has been researching urodynamics his entire career. He has lectured at the annual urology meeting on urodynamic evaluation and remains current on available systems.

A VIP search was conducted using the search criteria of NAICS Code: 339112 yielded 272 SDVOSBs & 52 VOSBs results. A search with the NAICS 339112 and keyword "Urodynamics" one SDVOSB yielded. A search with the NAICS 339112 and keyword "Urology" 3 SDVOSBS results. A website search was conducted, and a thorough search of the MSPV-NG Catalog was conducted using the keyword *Urodynamics* in attempt to find this product, which resulted no items being found in the catalog.

A website search was conducted and a thorough search of the NX Equipment Catalog was administered using the keyword *Urodynamics* in attempt to find this equipment, which resulted no items being found in the catalog.

A website search was conducted in GSA advantage does not provide the required product. Communication with Manufacturer resulted in the manufacturer, Laborie Medical Technologies, Corp. advising the item and software requested from the end user are proprietary owned and they do have distributors authorized to provide requirement. A sources sought notice was issued on FBO, which resulted three SDVOSBs indicating interest in this procurement. Two SDVOSBs are authorized distributor of Laborie Medical Technologies, Corp, a small business concern.
