

NOTICE OF INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE

The Department of Veterans Affairs, Network Contracting Office (NCO) 22, located at 4811 Airport Plaza Drive, Long Beach, CA 90815 is issuing this Notice of Intent (NOI) to inform industry contractors of the Government's intent to execute a Sole Source Award under FAR Part 13 – Simplified Acquisition Procedures (SAP), specifically [FAR Subpart 13.5 – Simplified Procedures for Certain Commercial Items](#).

The intended Contractor is **GE Medical Systems Information Technologies**, located at 8200 West Tower Avenue Milwaukee, WI 53223.

The VA San Diego Healthcare System (VASDHS) requires on-site preventive maintenance inspections per year per device, including all hardware parts, labor and intervening corrective maintenance service. Service also includes MS software security patch and update installation, as well as verification of back-up files. Telephone support offered 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, excluding holidays. Unlimited on-site service calls with a service response time of 5 business days. On-site work is for normal working hours, M-F, 8AM – 5PM. The GE Mars-Holter system is used by Cardiology for patient cardiac monitoring specifically for the VASDHS located at 3350 La Jolla Village Dr. San Diego, CA 92161.

GE Medical Systems Information Technologies is the original manufacturer of the Mars-Holter System. They are the only authorized preventive, corrective, and software maintenance service providers of this system and maintain proprietary rights of replacement parts, software, and servicing of this equipment. The Mars-Holter system is used extensively by Cardiology service to perform ambulatory electrocardiograph monitoring of patients. The system requires annual preventive maintenance service and continual corrective maintenance. If there are any SDVOSB/VOSB's that meets the need of this request, please submit your capability statement.

This procurement is being conducted using commercial item procedures pursuant to FAR Part 12 and FAR Part 13, specifically FAR Subpart 13.106-1(b)(1)(i) allowing the Contracting Officer (CO) to solicit from one source.

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) for this requirement is, 811219 – Other Electronic and Precision Equipment Repair and Maintenance. Product of Service Code for this requirement is J070 – Maintenance and Repair of Automatic Data Processing Equipment, Software, Supplies and Support Equipment. The Small Business Administration (SBA) size standard for this sector is \$22 Million.

This notice of intent is neither a formal solicitation nor a request for competitive proposals. No solicitation document is available and telephone requests will not be honored. No award will be made on the basis of unsolicited quotations or offers received in response to this notice. Any response to this notice must show clear, compelling and convincing evidence that competition will be advantageous to the Government. The intent of this synopsis is for informational purposes only. Information received will normally be considered solely for the purpose of determining whether to conduct a competitive procurement. A determination by the Government not to compete this action based on this notice is solely within the discretion of the Government.
