The purpose of this sources sought announcement is to gain knowledge of potential qualified Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB) or Veteran Owned Small Businesses (VOSB) interested and capable of providing fully functional Automated Pharmacy Verification Spur Workstations for the Department of Veterans Affairs Consolidated Mail Outpatient Pharmacy's (CMOP's) located in Leavenworth, Kansas.
