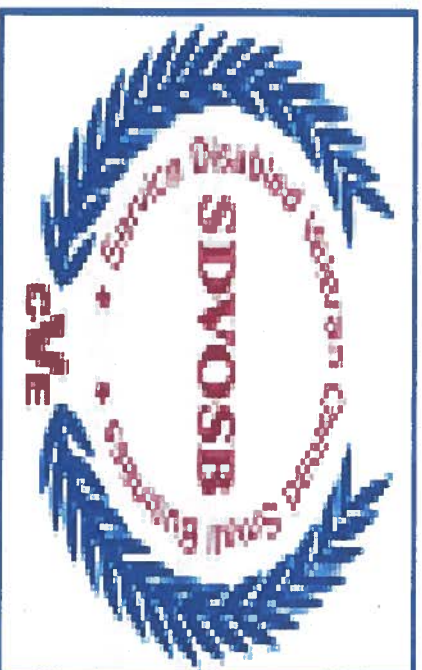

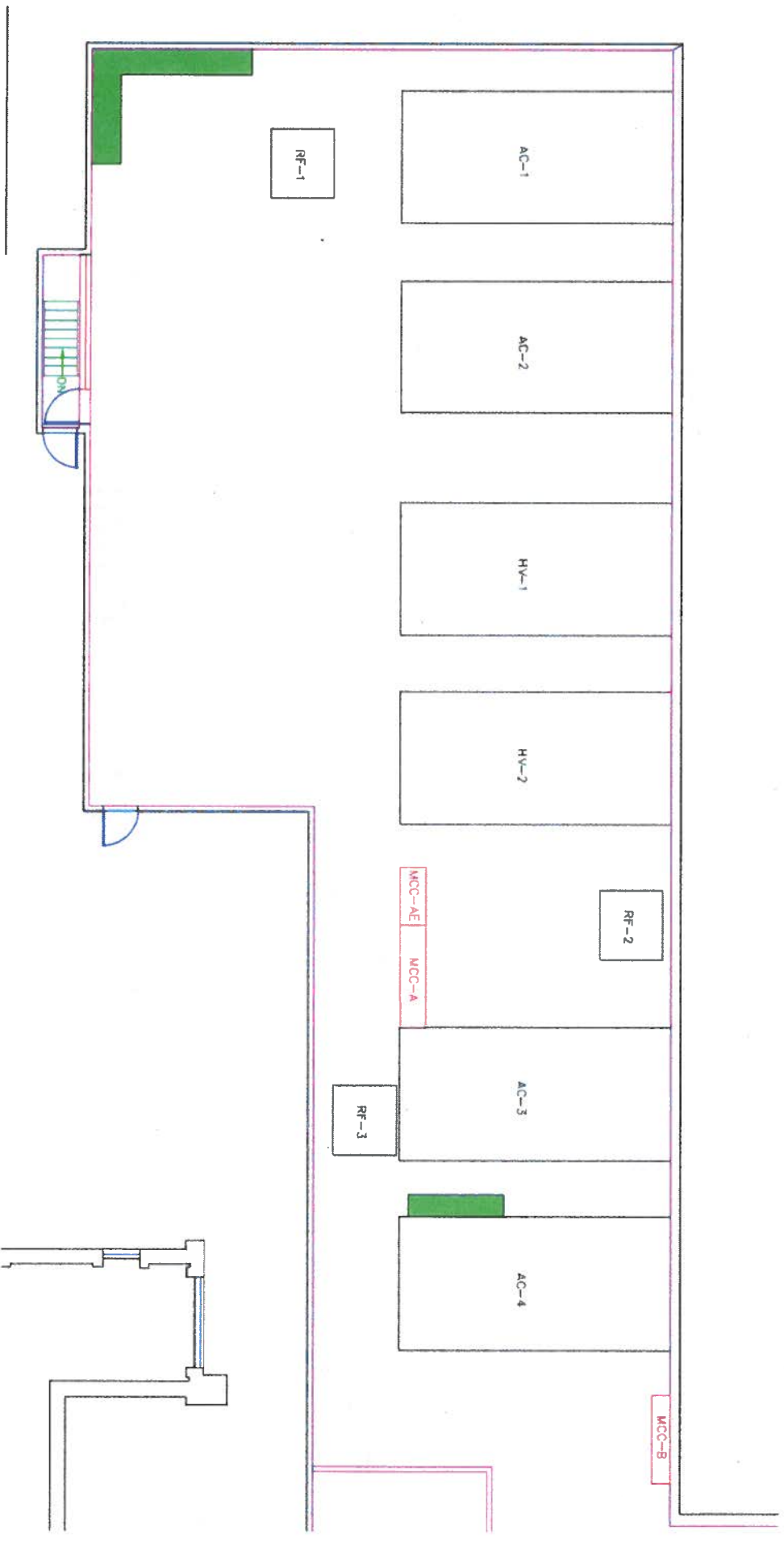
# TECHNICAL QUESTIONS

# MCC Replacement

- New home runs for feeds to all equipment loads.
- Feeders to each MCC can be extended via VA approved splicing method.
- Electrical plan for load transfers shall be submitted to VA prior to any work being done.
- All load transfers will be done at night or on weekends unless approved by COR.
