2. PROVIDE ACCESS PANELS OF APPROPRIATE SIZE, TYPE AND FIRE RATING FOR ALL CONCEALED ITEMS THAT REQUIRE ADJUSTMENT, MAINTENANCE, MONITORING, ETC. COORDINATE LOCATION WITH ARCHITECT.
3. DO NOT DETERMINE DIMENSIONS AND SIZES OF THE GRAPHIC REPRESENTATIONS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS BY USING MEASURING DEVICES (I.E. "SCALING"). RELY ON THE NUMERIC DIMENSIONS SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS FOR MEASUREMENT.
4. DIMENSIONS ON SMALL SCALE PLANS ARE NOMINAL UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
5. DIMENSIONS ON LARGE SCALE DETAILS ARE ACTUAL UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

- 1. WHERE REQUIREMENTS CALL FOR MATCHING EXISTING CONSTRUCTION, FINISHES, PRODUCTS, ETC., THE ARCHITECT'S DECISION WILL BE FINAL ON WHETHER THE MATCH IS ACCEPTABLE. IF THE MATCH IS NOT ACCEPTABLE, PROVIDE SAMPLES OF SUITABLE ALTERNATIVES FOR THE ARCHITECT'S SELECTION.
2. WHEN DIFFERENT CEILING HEIGHTS ARE ENCOUNTERED AFTER THE REMOVAL OF A PARTITION, SQUARE OFF THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL OFFSET. SPACE BETWEEN CEILING ELEVATIONS AND PATCH AND FINISH TO MATCH EXISTING ADJACENT CONSTRUCTION UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
3. UNDERCUT EXISTING DOORS AS NECESSARY TO CLEAR NEW FLOOR FINISHES.
