The requested prosthetic item will be purchased against a Federal Supply Schedule (FSS) contract and an urgent or compelling need exists, and following the FSS ordering procedures would result in unacceptable delays. Unusual and Compelling Urgency.

The prosthetic item is not available for purchase on an existing contract and will be purchased on an open market basis, and (1) the delivery time does not meet the patient's medical needs and there is medical documentation to support the compelling special need, or (2) a medical emergency exists and there is medical evidence to support the need.

Authorized or Required by Statute (Ref 38 U.S.C. § 8123).

The prosthetic item is not available for purchase on an existing contract and will be purchased on an open-market basis because the patient's medical needs cannot be met through the use of a required source of supply or service and there is medical documentation to support the need. The following describes the circumstances requiring purchase from one source:


