2. The Metasys Software available in the market is currently at revision 6.0 and with each year a new revision is released and available. Does the VA want to maintain the latest revision of software for the system? This would be called an annual Metasys software subscription service. If the VA wants this (which we highly recommend), the VA would need to create a new line item on each year of the price schedule for the Contractor to list the cost for this service. **Added Line Item for Service to all Years**

3. During the quarterly scheduled service description, it is clear that the VA wants 24 hours of on-site labor. Can this 24 hours (basically, 3 man days) be provided in 3 consecutive days per month to save cost of travel? **Yes that would be acceptable..**
