Questions

1. Will the government provide a lay-down area for office space and material storage that can be secured?

Need to know how much space will be required for each (office and storage)

2. The contractor will be responsible for provision of portable latrines, unless otherwise directed by the government--does the government agree to the rental of portable latrines?

No, the VA allows use of its facilities, see General Requirements' spec

3. Will the VA accept a prime-sub teaming arrangement? If so please identify any particulars to the VA above and beyond that required by the FAR subpart 9.6

Yes subcontracting arrangements are allowed. See VAAR 852.219-10, (a) (3) in the solicitation for additional information on necessary work percentages.

4. The NAICS code identified is 238220 (14 million SB size std), would the government consider a broader NAICS (236220) since there are a variety of subspecialties that need to be coordinated and managed (pipe-fitter/plumber, Electrical, Carpenter, among others)?

The most applicable NAICS code is chosen when soliciting a project, and it remains the most closely aligned code with the project.

5. We have both a superintendent and project manager with 30 hr OSHA certification. Does the government require OSHA certification above and beyond this?

All laborers require the 10-hour OSHA training but the super and PM do not need more than the 30-hour, unless there is a specific requirement on the project.
