



REFLECTED CEILING PLAN - DEMOLITION KEYNOTES

- 1 (E) SUNSCREEN TO REMAIN, U.N.O. REMOVE DEBRIS AND CLEAN VIA POWER WASH.
- 2 REMOVE LAY-IN CEILING GRID AND TILES, TYPICAL THIS FLOOR.
- 3 REMOVE CEILING LIGHTS, TYPICAL THIS FLOOR, U.N.O.
- 4 REMOVE CEILING MOUNTED SPEAKERS, TYPICAL THIS FLOOR, U.N.O.
- 5 REMOVE HVAC DIFFUSERS, TYPICAL THIS FLOOR, U.N.O.
- 6 REMOVE (E) CEILING ACCESS PANEL, TYPICAL THIS FLOOR
- 7 REMOVE GYPSUM BOARD CEILING, EXISTING FRAMING TO REMAIN, TYPICAL THIS FLOOR.
- 8 REMOVE CEMENT PLASTER SOFFIT. (E) FRAMING TO REMAIN TYP. THIS FLOOR.
- 9 (E) SKYLIGHTS AND SLOPED CEMENT PLASTER SOFFIT TO REMAIN, TYPICAL OF 7.
- 10 REMOVE CEILING MOUNTED PROJECTOR. REINSTALL IN SAME LOCATION AFTER NEW CEILING WORK IS COMPLETE.
- 11 REMOVE CEILING MOUNTED EQUIPMENT. REINSTALL IN SAME LOCATION AFTER NEW CEILING WORK IS COMPLETE.
- 12 REMOVE CEILING LIGHTS, TYPICAL THIS ROOM. (DEDUCTIVE ALTERNATE 4: CEILING LIGHTS TO REMAIN)
- 13 REMOVE CEILING MOUNTED SPEAKERS, TYPICAL THIS ROOM. (AT DEDUCTIVE ALTERNATE 4: CEILING MOUNTED SPEAKERS TO REMAIN)
- 14 REMOVE HVAC DIFFUSERS, TYPICAL THIS ROOM. (AT DEDUCTIVE ALTERNATE 4: HVAC DIFFUSERS TO REMAIN)
- 15 REMOVE GYPSUM BOARD CEILING, TYPICAL THIS ROOM. (AT DEDUCTIVE ALTERNATE 4: GYPSUM BOARD CEILING TO REMAIN)
- 16 REMOVE GYPSUM BOARD, FURRING & INSULATION AT BOTTOM OF EXISTING ROOF JOISTS
- 17 CEMENT PLASTER TRELLIS TO REMAIN
- 18 REMOVE CEILING MOUNTED PROJECTOR. RETURN TO OWNER.
