1. Procuring Contracting Activity:

Department of Veterans Affairs, SAO Central Region, 708 S. Third Street, Minneapolis, MN 55417 for the Department of Veterans Affairs, Louis Stokes Cleveland VA Medical Center, 10701 East Boulevard, Cleveland, OH 44106.

2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:

Justification and approval for Other Than Full and Open Competition, for three (3) complete Berchtold Surgery Systems to include lights, monitor arms, booms and installation to equip three (3) surgery suites of a newly leased Ambulatory Surgery Center (ASC) for the Louis Stokes Cleveland VA Medical Center, Cleveland, OH per Purchase Requests #541-13-3-250-0239. Award of a firm-fixed price contract is anticipated to: Berchtold Corporation, 1950 Hanahan Road, Charleston., SC 29406

3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

This procurement is to provide, install and certify the Berchtold Surgery Suite Lighting/Equipment solutions for the newly leased ASC's and are comprised of the below items. The configuration is similar to current surgery suites at the VA Medical center and ensures a seamless transition for Facility Surgeons when performing surgery for VA Beneficiaries, greatly enhancing patient safety and surgeon confidence.

4. **Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition:** FAR 13.501(a)(2) under the auspices of FAR Part 6.302-1(a)(2) "Only one responsible source and no other supplies or services will satisfy agency requirements.
5. **Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):**
- a. The Louis Stokes Cleveland VA currently uses the Berchtold lighting system in the Operating Rooms at the Wade Park main facility. Surgeons are familiar with the lights, monitor arms and booms at Wade Park and have come to rely on the adjustable light temperature feature (3600Kelvin, 4000Kelvin and 5000Kelvin) that the Berchtold lights offer. Due to the types of cases being performed at the ASC, user customizable light temperatures that range from 3600K to 5000K are imperative. Most of the cases performed at the ASC will be Ophthalmic, Podiatric, Plastic or Endoscopic in nature. Having the capability to perform surgery under lights at 3600K and up to 5000K will greatly assist the surgeon to differentiate between good and bad tissue and identify blood and tissue from the underlying vasculature. For the longer Podiatric surgeries, a temperature of 5000K is appropriate as it will allow the surgeons the ability to identify bones and nerves more readily. As the Cleveland VA Medical Center is a teaching hospital, it will also greatly assist in the instruction of students and residents.
 - b. The configuration is similar to current surgery suites at the Louis Stokes Cleveland VA Medical center and ensures a seamless transition for Facility Surgeons when performing surgery for VA Beneficiaries, greatly enhancing patient safety and surgeon confidence. This technology was intended to be standardized throughout the facility for developing end user staff competency through the utilization of technology that meets the needs of Care/Service line procedures. By having a standardized system, Biomedical Engineering staff will develop a competency in the maintenance and repair of these systems as well. It has been determined that standardization of these specialized systems saves healthcare facilities inordinate amounts of money in these two areas.
 - c. As denoted, the Berchtold System that will be supplied and distributed by Berchtold who as the only authorized distributor, will provide a comprehensive light and boom network that will be utilized in the ASC's suites shown above in Item 3. These suites have specific applications & procedures which will rely on the Berchtold lighting and boom system to function. The Berchtold system includes: Cabling for the various endoscope systems and physiological patient monitoring inputs. Monitor booms, mounts, shelves for endoscope, physiological patient monitoring equipment Monitors for displaying the outputs of endoscope and physiological patient monitoring. Control workstation for determining the appropriate system, displays. Power and utilities integration. Installation and programming of the complete system.

6. **Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:** This action will be synopsisized and published on the Government Point of Entry, FedBizOpps.
7. **Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:** There is prior commercial pricing data for the systems being procured as well as pricing for recent upgrades, which will allow a comparative analysis of pricing offered for the current system(s) to be procured.
8. **Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:** Market research was conducted through online research of specifications needed and by comparing costs from other Operating Room Suite upgrades. Market research did conclude that no other vendor's system offered the range of light temperature and specifications required.
9. **Any Other Facts Supporting the Use of Other than Full and Open Competition:** There are no other facts supporting the use of Other Than Full and Open Competition.
10. **Listing of Sources that Expressed, in Writing, an Interest in the Acquisition:** This J&A will be posted on FedBizOpps. If responses to the synopsis indicate that additional sources are available, the file will be documented accordingly and the requirement competed among all eligible sources.


